

# E-rate at a Glance



## Schools and Libraries Program

### What is E-rate?

The Schools and Libraries Program of the Universal Service Fund, commonly known as "E-rate," is administered by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) under the direction of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), and provides discounts to assist schools and libraries to obtain affordable telecommunications and Internet access.

The Schools and Libraries Program supports broadband connectivity to the building and broadband services within the building. Funding is requested under two categories of service: Category One (telecommunications and Internet access) and Category Two (internal connections, Wi-Fi and basic maintenance). Discounts for support depend on the level of poverty and the urban/rural status of the population served. Discounts range from 20% to 90% on eligible services for schools, districts, libraries or consortium applicants.

### Program Forms

**470** – Required for any desired services to open a competitive bid process. Can be filed any time when services are sought.

**471** – Must be filed annually within published window period. Application for funding on services bid.

**486** – Certifications form must be filed the later of 120 days after service start date or the FCDL date.

**472** – For reimbursement of services paid if not discounted on vendor invoice.

**500** – Release unused C2 funds to clear entity C2 budget

**479** – Consortium CIPA requirement due by June 30.

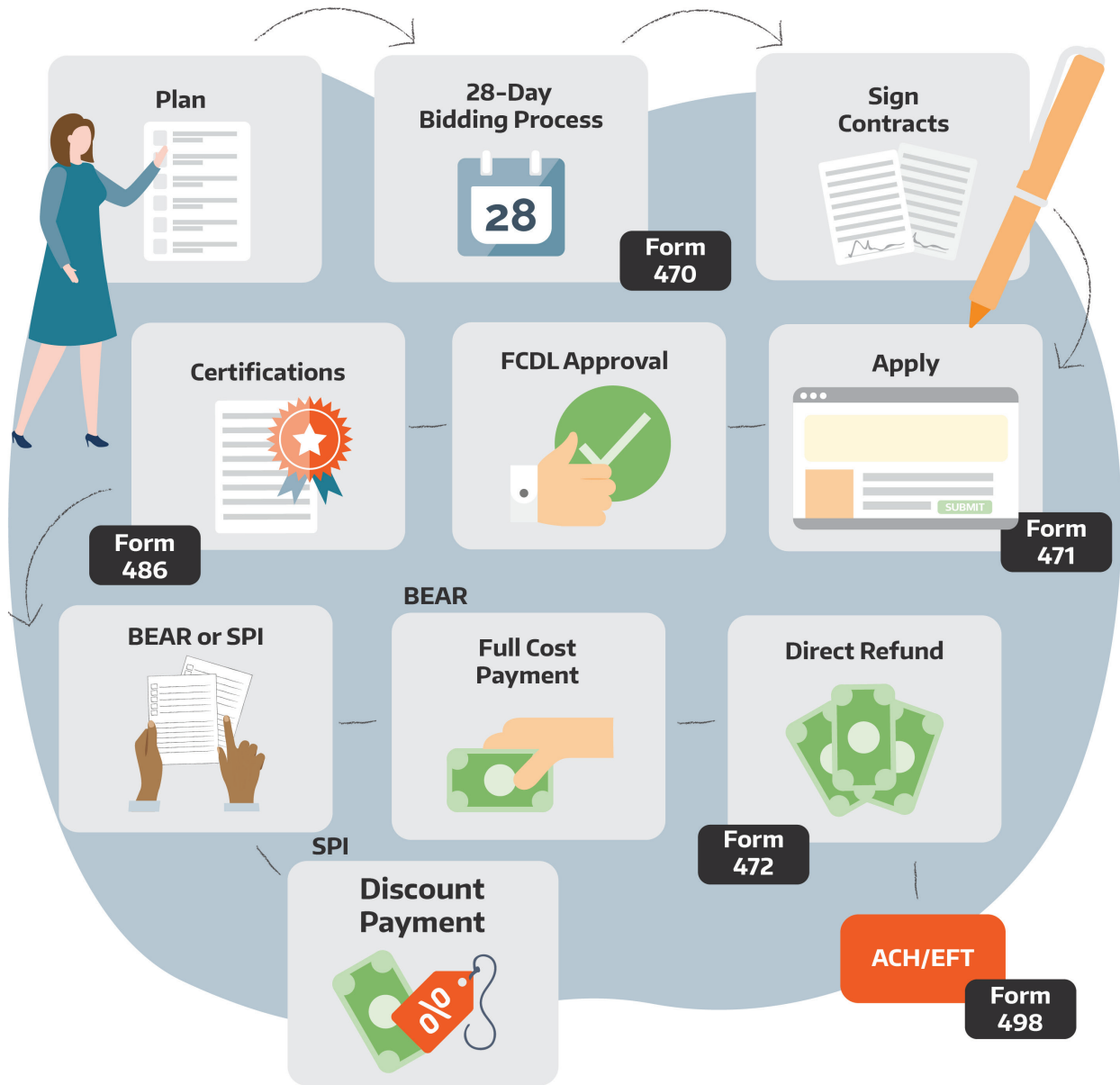
486 – Notify services began and
